1. PRESENT.

6. MATTERS ARISING.

Remind Highways England to extend road sweeping along A38 into village. (Re-open Public Session).

Resident proposed tree planting at St Richards Close/De Wyche Close, permission required from WDC and Fortis Housing Association (Close Public session).

7. POLICE REPORT.

- 3. 106 FUNDING PROPOSALS PROPOSED APPOINTMENT OF BELLINGER DESIGN, Following discussion it was proposed by Councillor Mrs. Harrigan and seconded by Councillor Mrs. Keane to appoint Bellinger Design to prepare a vision design plan for the playing fields. Costs on a pro-rata basis.

 DISABLED SWING. To ensure the appropriate equipment was purchased it was agreed to consult the child's family.
- 4. <u>M5 SMART MOTORWAY.</u> Highways England had provided a monthly update. Councillor Lady Judge was keen to hold a special meeting to discuss the anticipated noise problems.

- 1. NEW HOMES BONUS APPLICATION. A larger project to be considered.
- 2. WORCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL PROPOSED EXTENSION TO WYCHBOLD SCHOOL. Request for access via Community Hall car park. Worcestershire County Council required heavy vehicle access via the Community Hall car park to the school development. This would involve removing a section of boundary fence and hedge.

Compensation and re-instatement of car park surface to be considered.

Risk assessment to be carried out.

It was agreed to seek professional advice.

3. <u>DEFIBRILLATOR – NHB.</u> Further fund raising taking place.

- 4. <u>COMMUNITY TREE PACKS WOODLAND TRUST</u>. The scheme is designed to attract community groups who wish to plant trees on publicly accessable land. Land owners permission required. The two "greens" De Wyche Close and St. Richards Close and the M5 islands may be suitable locations.
- 5. <u>ALLOTMENTS.</u> Overgrowth on allotments required attention, replacement fencing to be considered, in addition the boundary to Stoke Road required fencing, alternatively hedge laying was an option.
- 6. <u>REQUEST FOR COMMEMMORATVE PLAQUE.</u> The football club made a request for a plaque to be fixed to a bench overlooking the football pitch in commemoration to Alan Brown a lifelong member of Wychbold Football Club. The Council were all in favor of the request.
