# Minutes Of The Annual Meeting Held On Wednesday 17<sup>th</sup> May 2022 at 7.00pm in the Village Hall

#### 1. <u>Election Of Chairperson</u>

Cllr B Spence proposed Cllr Bewsher for the role of Chair for the next 12 months, Cllr Rands seconded the vote, all other Councillors accepted this proposal and Cllr Bewsher accepted the position. The Clerk presented the Acceptance of Office to Chair Bewsher for sign and the duly witnessed it.

#### 2. <u>Election Of Vice Chairperson</u>

Vice Chairperson B Spence resigned his position as Vice Chairperson. Cllr R Cheape proposed Cllr B Spence for Vice Chairperson, seconded by Chair R Bewsher. Cllr Spence said he would accept the position. The Clerk presented the Acceptance of Office to Chair Bewsher for sign and the duly witnessed it.

#### 4. Minutes of last meeting

Minutes of the Last Annual General Meeting Held Wednesday 5th May 2021 (via Zoom owing to the Coronavirus Regulations) were approved and signed by Chair Bewsher at the OM held on 21<sup>st</sup> September 2021.

#### 6. Chairperson's Report on Parish Council Achievements In 2021/2022

Chair Bewsher gave a full account of the achievements of the Parish Council and thanked all Councillors and the Clerk for their work and efforts over the last 12 months. A notable achievement had been the introduction of a 30-mph speed limit through Upper Bentley, but she expressed frustration at the lack of support from WCC Highways in the introduction of a 40-mph speed limit along Cur and Copyholt Lanes. Chair Bewsher thanked WCC Cllr Kit Taylor for his continued support on both introducing the speed limit but also on several other issues.

Chair Bewsher updated the AGM on the work in relation to potential legal proceedings concerning the Foxlydiate development and highlighted the inconsistency between financial contributions to support School Travel for much smaller developments compared to Foxlydiate. Chair Bewsher particularly wished to thank the members of the local community who had contributed to the Parish Council's legal "fighting fund" and thanked Clirs Boss and Rands for their work in generating donations.

Vice Chair Spence remarked that the Chair's presentation gave such a clear view of the work of the Parish Council and the issues that it is addressing that this should be circulated to all residents. He suggested that if Chair Bewsher sent him the script he would add some graphics in the style of the Bentley Bugle Clerk Dyson could then distribute the document electronically. The council supported this proposal.
