Present were eight Parish Councillors, the Clerk, and three members of the public (one of whom also a member of the press).

The minutes of the previous year's Parish Meeting on the 13th of May 2021 were agreed as a true record and signed by the Chairman of the Parish Council.

The Chairman's report was presented, paying particular tribute to those involved in Covid-19 assistance such as St Peter's Coronavirus Support Group and regular foodbank collections, and also to other notable occurrences that have taken place over the last year. The report also gave our thoughts to those who have been affected by the loss of a loved one or friend. To those who have had covid-19, and those who are still suffering with long covid. The Chairman paid tribute to ex Parish Councillor Mike Johnson who was the longest concurrent standing Councillor in recent history. The newest Parish Councillor Angie Wytcherley was welcomed. Enhancements to the parks and greens spaces were well received such as the planned pump track and outdoor gym equipment. A new member of the local Police team has joined the community team, St Peter's have one of the lowest reported crime rates in the city. Several matters relating to planning decisions by the district council and the poor quality of planning applications was noted.
