71/20 Apologies

To consider acceptance of apologies for absence from Councillors: Cllrs. Mr C Rouse and Mr A Turner (accepted).

72/20 Interests

73/20 Reports from other representatives

To receive reports from County and District Councillors, Malvern Hills Trust, Tree and Footpaths Wardens and other representatives:

District & County Clir. Prof John Raine and District Clir. Natalie McVey reported that both District and County Councils were holding their ordinary meetings online. Recycling rates had improved and it was noted also that domestic waste collection quantities had increased since the Covid 19 restrictions. Finally they confirmed that all local 'rough sleepers' were being housed in Worcester.
