Draft Minutes of a Meeting held in Mamble Village Hall on Thursday 2nd June 2022 at 7.15pm.

Present:Cllrs: Mr C Bunn (Chairman), Mrs S Rawlins, Mrs J Rogers and Mr P Bytheway.In Attendance:Mrs A Watson (Clerk) and parishioner Mr W Coley

1. Apologies: These were received and accepted from Cllr. Mr S Finney and Cllr. D Godwin.

2. Declarations of Interest: None

2.1 Dispensation has been granted to Cllr. Bunn at each meeting for a Declaration of Pecuniary Interest, to enable participation in all discussions relating to the 'Lengthsman'.

3. Suspension of the meeting for the Democratic 15 mins/Public Question Time: The Chairman welcomed Mr Coley, and invited him to address the meeting. Mr Coley raised concerns regarding the extent of recent mowing alongside Lower Moorend Farm, which on this occasion had removed all wild flower and areas for wildlife on a large area of verge, which he stated was not in line with County Council policy. Councillors noted that this area had been mown by parishioners for many years, to assist with visibility on a dangerous bend at that point in the road, and a brief discussion took place. Councillors and Mr Coley agreed that a compromise between the requirement of road safety and the need to preserve areas for wildlife and wild flowers was needed, which the Chairman will address. The Chairman thanked Mr Coley for his attendance and he left the meeting at 7.20pm.

4. Minutes: The minutes of the Annual Meeting of the Parish Council held on the 5th May 2022 were approved and signed by the Chairman.

5. Jubilee Street Party and Big Lunch Celebration Sunday 5th June 12pm-6pm. Final preparations were agreed, with all volunteers meeting at 11.15am on Sunday 5th June. Signs will be put up for the road closure and to indicate the Sun & Slipper pub is open as usual. If the rain is too bad on the day, the party will be held in the Village Hall; however the road closure will still go ahead as planned.
