- **2. Declaration of Interests:** All Councillors were reminded of their duty to keep their register of interests updated and were asked to declare any personal interests in items on the agenda.
- **3.** Minutes: The minutes of the meeting held on 2nd October 2018 were approved and signed.

4. Progress Reports:

- a. **M50 bridge works.** Work is ongoing on the M50 bridge propping. Regular communications are being received from the Highways Agency. Still no confirmation on when work on the Queens Arms bridge will commence.
- b. **Speeding:** The Clerk to arrange a survey with the Highways Division to look into ways to improve the speed limit markings around the Parish as well as to address some issues with the road markings and road conditions.
- c. Litter bin in School Lane: Agreed that this should be relocated on the opposite side of the road.
- d. **SWDP Review Briefing feedback.:** Cllr Humphreys attended the briefing and reported back that the review is in its early stages but it's unlikely that the Parish will see any significant housing developments.
