Agenda item 17/45: Environmental & Community Wellbeing

a) Road closure – Kendal End Road / Fiery Hill Road / Bittell Road.

The condition of the roads that have been used for the detour is causing great concern to residents, not helped by wet weather. WCC is to be asked to ensure restitution measures when the road junction is re-opened. The parish council has been made aware that the effect of the road closure on local business is harmful.

b) Condition of roads in the parish

Members will be aware of the deleterious condition of most roads in the parish. A local resident draws attention to the lower half of Fiery Hill Road, adjoining roads and pavements stating "that lower straight run from outside the station/where Ringway finished, that is awful/not of a standard that is acceptable to the residents.

Fortuitous it may have been, the Cala Homes development, now highlights the need for this to be done...residents of that, already commenting about FHill road surface not being up to what this village expects.

"Scruffy, unkempt not what it should be."

The EO was informed before Christmas that Sandhills Lane had been included in the 'Driving Home' scheme (this is how the programme is described on the Worcestershire County Council website: We've been busy since the start of the two year Driving Home Programme, improving the roads that residents have told us are most important to them. So far since the start of the programme last April, we have delivered 65 miles of improvements directly benefiting over 7,200 homes and 17,000 residents across the county.) see - http://www.worcestershire.gov.uk/info/20007/travel and roads/1177/driving home

The request via 'report-it' ticket number 279870 for a starting date to Sandhills Lane has yet to be answered.

- c) To arrange dates for public consultation regarding proposed equipment on playing field and any other current issues.
 - The Bulletin carries information alerting readers to the fact that the parish council will be undertaking public consultation on the suitability of outdoor gym equipment at Barnt Green playing field during March. Members are asked to volunteer to help with the consultation events. The Bulletin also states residents can voice opinions at the Parish Meeting which is to be held on 26th April.
- d) To be aware of, and agree to, revised costs for emptying the playing field litter bins. Bromsgrove District Council currently empty the bins on Barnt Green playing field; no revised costs were notified for 2015/16 so the recent bill of an 80% increase was a shock! The EO and Cllr CH met with the relevant BDC officer to discuss the situation which is due to improvements in BDC admin and business practice and efforts to streamline the system. Cllr CH to report.
