3. Emergency Services & Security

THE PRESENT SITUATION

The villages have no emergency services of their own. Policing is covered from Bewdley (Pound Green) or from Kidderminster (Arley and Shatterford), and response times are felt by many to be too long. The service provided by the Beat Officer team has improved, but still falls short on occasions. The ambulance service is provided from Kidderminster, and the fact that many cases must go to Worcester is a cause of great concern.

Issues

- Disruption caused by "boy racers".
- Security of isolated properties.
- Distance to Royal Worcester Hospital
- Ambulances and fire engines sometimes attend on the wrong side of the river.
- CCTV
- Police response times
- Police contacts with the community.
