

# Hill and Moor Parish Council

## *Newsletter*

Many people attended the Public Meeting with the police and Cllr Liz Tucker held on Monday 30th September to put forward their experiences of anti-social behaviour in the village. It appeared that a small number of people were causing the majority of the problems.

Some incidents reported were more of an annoyance, with eggs thrown at houses, but others were more concerning and the police were following up on these reports.

PC Brown of the Local Police Team has pledged to set up a follow up event, likely to take place early in the New Year, with other emergency services to help provide additional information for residents. Few of the incidents mentioned at the meeting had been reported to the police.

The message from the police was to report all incidences, no matter how small. It is not so much about getting a police car to visit there and then, but to log the amount of incidents there are. The reports will prompt routine patrols in the area if they are sufficiently numerous.

We would urge you to report any incident of anti-social behaviour or crime that you encounter by calling 101, the non-urgent crime number (unless it is an emergency, in which case call 999). If you can't get through, wait until later or the following day. It doesn't matter if the incident took place sometime earlier, the problem will be logged and if the number of incidents reported is high, then regular patrols by police officers become more likely.

At the public meeting, there had been a call for CCTV on the playing field at the meeting, and the Parish Council is looking into this. We have also

enquired about using Wychavon's mobile CCTV camera – a Wychavon officer will visit the village to see if this would be possible.

There will be a patrol in the village on Halloween, as requested at the public meeting.
