Community Fund project: following the Public Meeting, where the two Village Hall projects received the majority vote of those present, it was proposed by Cllr. Mr. Humphries, seconded by Cllr. Mr. Hill and **resolved** by a vote of 4 for with 1 abstention to present to Solarig the two proposals submitted by the Village Hall Committee in order that they can make necessary arrangement to purchase the goods requested from the Community Fund.

New Homes Bonus application: it was agreed to submit an application for £500 towards the cost of a defibrillator and external cabinet. Following questions raised by the Village Hall Committee the following was agreed:

- a) That a ball park figure of £20 per annum should cover the electricity cost.
- b) Two representatives will be appointed by the Council to check the defibrillator on a weekly basis when the defibrillator is purchased.
- c) The Evesham Community First Responder, at the September meeting, said that he would offer training sessions as many times as the Community want it.
- d) The defibrillator will be available to anyone that requires its use.
- e) The Council will pay for professional installation work and connection to an electrical power supply and will make good any disturbance to the building.

Village Hall Committee asked to respond to the Clerk by the 7th November if they have any further queries before the application is submitted.
