- 3238 MINUTES OF THE ANNUAL PARISH COUNCIL MEETING held on 14<sup>th</sup> November 2018 had been circulated. Cllr Mr P Langham proposed and seconded by Cllr Mr M Bates and it was AGREED that the minutes of the Parish Council meeting be signed by the Chairman as a correct record.
- 3239 PROGRESS REPORTS
  - a. Police update (3226a) PCSO Vicky Elliott had sent in a report highlighting one burglary to a house, one to a non-dwelling, one to the village hall, one car vandalised and a land rover stolen.
  - b. EVOLIS Radar Speed Sign (3226b) The Clerk has ordered the two posts that can be installed by the Lengthsman, when this has been done, he will order the VAS which will cost £3,000.
  - c. Speeding in the village Meeting with WCC Highways (3226c) The Clerk, Cllr M Bates and Cllr M Hadley met with Gerry Brienza, Senior Highways Liaison Engineer and Kieran Hemstock, Worcestershire Highways, Partnership in Wychavon, WCC. During the v productive meeting we identified 13 possible solutions to speeding in the village, some we had already put into action, some required street lighting and some could make a difference, but the PC would have to fund the activities. The Clerk was asked to publish a full report in the Chronicle.
  - d. PC Notice Board at the Village Hall (3226d) the Clerk had been in contact with the car owner's insurance coy who were still investigating the accident but had registered the PC's claim. The clerk had also informed the PC insurance coy, if we must claim through them there is a £250 excess. The Clerk was instructed to order a new metal notice board, estimated at £1,266 +VAT and Tom Manders will do the installation.
  - e. Three drains in Church Road need repair (3226e) the Clerk was asked to inform WCC Highways again of the three drains in Church Road which had sunk and were a danger to vehicles, he had also informed Gerry Brienza, Senior Highways Liaison Engineer, WCC.
  - f. Gigabit Broadband Voucher Scheme (3226g) –this would be for residents of Stock Green whereby each resident can claim a voucher of £500 per a property and £2,500 for a property with a business from a Government scheme. The Clerk had included a form for residents to complete in the December Chronicle for the residents to return the Clerk who will then co-ordinate the results with BT Openreach and is now awaiting a quote for the installation.
  - g. Visit to Severn Waste recovery site (4243). The clerk had made contact with Michelle James who had suggested Friday 1<sup>st</sup> March, Monday 4<sup>th</sup> March and Friday 8<sup>th</sup> March, the clerk would send round a "doodle".
